



# CACHET WINE

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## Bourgogne Rouge "Vieilles Vignes" 2021, Domaine Machard de Gramont

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**Code** BOUR003

This is a beautifully pure expression of village Pinot. A blend of old vine Bourgogne Pinot Noir, including fruit grown in the 'Chapitre' vineyard, where only 10% of a normal crop was produced. A sumptuous mid-week red Burgundy!

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### **Tasting Notes:**

The colour is perfect, and the nose attractive and inviting, with aromas of sweet jammy red fruits, oak and a fresh green herb character. The palate is soft, rounded and layered, seductive throughout and showing fresh red fruits, smoky, gamey flavours, a hint of minerality and a lush, even and balanced finish.

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## Specification

<b>Vinification</b>	A highly acclaimed Pinot Noir, produced from vines averaging 60 years old. The main part of the wine is sourced from vineyards around Beaune, Marsannay and Nuits St George, with 10% of the fruit from the Chapitre vineyard next to Marsannay. All hand picked, with a sorting at the winery to discard unripe or poor fruit. 100% destemmed, and ferment takes place in tank with daily remontage to extract tannins and colour gently. The wine is transferred into used oak barrels, with a mixture of American, French and Hungarian oak.
