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## Château Capet Duverger

### 2019, Saint Emilion Grand Cru

The estate has been owned by the Duverger family for nine generations. The current owner, Michel Duverger, former president of the Union des Producteurs de Saint-Émilion, continues to uphold his family's legacy with the production of a classic Saint-Émilion Grand Cru from his 7.68 hectares of vines. A Merlot-based wine, made up of 65% Merlot and 35% Cabernet Franc boasts a strong structure, with rich, spicy fruit and remarkable length. The juicy plummy black fruits are complemented by fine tannins and the subtle complexity of Cabernet Franc. Aged in barrels, with 30% being new, it offers depth and refinement.
