



# CACHET WINE

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## Ile de Beaute Blanc, Domaine Barcelo

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**Code** BARC015

This delicious Corsican wine expresses all the attributes of a high-end Corsican wine. The harmony of continental and indigenous grape varieties on this recognized "Terroir" gives elegance and aromatized wines with high potential.

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**Tasting Notes:**

Yellow and light with greenish hues. A fine, expressive, complex nose, with aromas of citrus and white flowers. The palate is at first fresh and sumptuous, ending with a pleasant fruity acidity.

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| <b>Vinification</b>      | The grapes are picked in the early hours to retain freshness and avoid partial oxidation. Pressed and the juice transferred into temperature controlled steel tank for fermentation. The wine, once fermented, undergoes partial malolactic, before ageing on lees for three months with one battonage (lees stirring).  |
