

Jordan Cabernet Sauvignon 2017

From one of California's most awarded wine estates and modelled after a First Growth Bordeaux, Jordan is a classic Californian Cabernet Sauvignon that has been considered one of Sonoma's best Cabernet Sauvignons for four decades with its perfect balance between beautiful fruit, silky tannins and a lingering finish.

Tasting Notes:

Black cherry, raspberry and clove aromas mingle beautifully with subtle hints of vanilla. The palate has a velvety richness that coats the mouth in concentrated flavors of black cherries, blackberries and a hint of nutmeg.

Vinification	The vineyards are broken into a myriad of at least 20 separate blocks, each picked and fermeted separately. Once harvested, the grapes are optically sorted, cooled and destemmed. Fermentation is in temperature controlled steel tanks, with each vineyard block fermented as an individual wine. After 10 days the wine is transferred into new and used French oak (100%) to finish fermentation. Racking takes place in the Spring, and the wine benefits from 18 months in 100% French oak, with barrels hand-picked.
