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## Poças Fora da Série Acrobata, Manoel Poças

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**Code** POCA415

White wine produced from the Códega, Arinto and Rabigato grape varieties. The prolonged aging in barrel gives a perfect balance between the oxidative profile of prolonged aging and the freshness of high-altitude vineyards.

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**Tasting Notes:**

Notes of toast, country flowers, citrus fruit. Good mouth volume, crisp acidity with smooth tannins. Compelling, pretty dry and fresh.
