



# CACHET WINE

## Tongue Twister Vinho Verde

**Code** TONG001

Called 'Tongue Twister' after the names of some of the indigenous Portuguese grape varieties, this elegant, fresh wine has a lovely vibrant acidity and is delicious as an aperitif or with seafood, light cheeses or salads.

### Tasting Notes:

Yellow straw in colour with a green hue in the glass. On the nose the aromas are intensely citrusy with subtle notes of a more bitter orange peel and floral acacia. On the palate, this wine is both elegant and fresh, with vibrant acidity and juicy peach notes. The citric flavours are persistent and are coupled with a refreshing minerality. The texture is silky and balanced, with a long finish.
